I. POLICY

The senior officer on duty will determine when to notify the Chief of Police or request his/her presence at any location.

A. The Chief of Police shall be notified of any of the following circumstances:

1. Any officer involved shooting.
2. Any serious physical injury to any officer or public employee.
3. Any crime or incident resulting in the death of a person within the department's jurisdiction.
4. Any serious crime against a federal, state, or municipal government and/or employee.
5. Any crime involving an employee as a suspect.
6. Any incident or disturbance requiring a call-out of departmental officers.
7. Any crime so unusual that it would shock the conscience of the public.
8. Any time that the senior officer on duty determines that it is necessary to have the Chief of Police present.

B. The Chief of Police shall have the responsibility to call the Mayor on a matter of official interest to the Mayor.
