Police Seek Two Suspects in Forgery Ring

On 8/10/2011 at approximately 3:00 p.m., Pine Bluff Police Detectives were dispatched to the 3100 block of West 28th Avenue to a report of forgery in progress. When they arrived, Detectives Lambert and Oliver made contact with the individual who had attempted to cash a check in the store, and discovered that the check was fraudulent. The check was listed as being drawn from the National Bank of Commerce in Pine Bluff, a bank that has not been in business in Pine Bluff for approximately over 15 years. This incident has sparked a widespread investigation that spans at least four southeast Arkansas counties thus far, including Jefferson, Arkansas, Cleveland, and Grant counties.

Several arrests have been made in this fraudulent check ring, and police are seeking information on the whereabouts of two subjects:

Mr. Antonio R. Martin, B/M, DOB 10/07/1985

Ms. Sherrell Carr, B/F, DOB 11/21/1988

Police are seeking information that could lead to the capture of the two suspects. Any information should be forwarded to Detective Division at 870-730-2090. Detectives Jerry Lambert and Marcia Oliver are the lead detectives on this case.
