Armed & Dangerous Suspect at Large

At approximately 5:50 pm on February 14th, 2011 officer of the Pine Bluff Police Department were dispatched to 2100 E Harding (Regency Inn) in reference to a shooting.

Upon arrival officers was met by Justin Sullivan (D.O.B. 3-17-1983). Mr. Sullivan stated he had been shot. Mr. Sullivan was shot twice, once in the lower right abdomen and once on his lower left leg. Mr. Sullivan was transported to Jefferson Regional Medical Center for his injuries.

Witnesses at the scene stated Roderick Burnett is the suspect that shot Mr. Sullivan. Mr. Burnett was seen leaving in a white Chevrolet Corsica. The Corsica was located next door at the Fina gas station but Mr. Burnett was not with the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle was detained and transported to the detective's office for further questioning.

Investigators later determined that 23 year old B/M Roderick Lionel Burnett, of 2611 West 34th in Pine Bluff was the primary suspect in the shooting. Roderick Burnett also has a previous felony warrant out of Jefferson County. He should be considered Armed and Dangerous.

Burnett is 5"10" tall and weight around 195 pounds. He has black hair and brown eyes and a medium complexion.
